- 8 Members are expected neither to obstruct Pilatessuisse nor to bring its name into disrepute.
- 9 Members recognise and respect their own professional and personal limitations.
- 10 Members reflect upon their own work and seek to educate themselves further, both professionally and personally.
- 11 Members take account of the personalities of their clients and respect their social and ethnic background, way of life and ethical values.
- 12 Members deal with their clients' data and information in confidence.
